Council Notes...

Recycling: The City recycling receptacle will be moving to a new location to the lot North of the City **Building.** Contaminated items disqualify the loads. Plastic bags, pizza boxes, plastic oil jugs, gas cans, pet food bags, litter boxes need to go in for routine garbage pick up. Plastic bags are considered "tanglers" for the equipment when bailing. Please remember - when in doubt just throw it out. Do not put it in for recycling as it can disqualify the entire batch and be a hazard for those doing the sorting.

Snow Removal: Please keep the streets clear for snow removal and Emergency Equipment to get through.

Voting: The Webster County Auditor has made the decision to move the City voting site to the Badger Fire Station. Reference was made to the census numbers in Newark Township, expenses on equipment and lack of workers available to work the polling sites. As of this point it is considered a "temporary" move until the redistricting has taken place. The City of Vincent had no part in this decision making process. Voting options will be at the Webster County Court House up to the day prior of election day or in the Badger Fire Station on election day. Please take time to vote as this is a example of how quickly things can change.

Property for Sale: The City has several lots available for purchase. **School Street Addition** guidelines are available on the City



web-site. Please keep in mind, there is a 5 year tax abatement program - this is available for any resident that meets the guidelines including new structure or costly renovations.
